

One week-end in Weimar

Day 1

Friday is the perfect day to start your cultural weekend. After checking into your hotel, you can hire an **iGuide** from the Tourist Information Office and take a guided audio tour of Weimar at your own pace. Take a break for tea or coffee in one of Weimar's sunny squares: Herdeplatz, Theaterplatz or Frauenplan. After refreshing yourself at the hotel, enjoy good **Thuringian cuisine** at one of our famous restaurants or an opera or a concert at the **German National Theatre (DNT)**. Afterwards, enjoy a drink in a bar, in a chic KAWA or an interesting ACC.



Day 2

This day is for your **Top Highlights**. First, make sure you book a time slot for the **Herzogin Anna Amalia Library**, one of Germany's most fascinating libraries. Then you can continue with the classics and visit **Goethe's National Museum and Residence**. It is time for lunch at Herderplatz: choose a soup bar for something light or a local restaurant for something more substantial. Then take a short trip to the **Belvedere Castle**. Do not forget to visit the Orangery. For a dinner, choose a place on the Frauenplan.



Day 3

The last day, but no less interesting. Today's theme is **Modernism**. After breakfast, start with an introduction to modernism at the **Museum Neues Weimar**. Then visit one of Weimar's top attractions, the **Bauhaus Museum**, which houses the oldest collection selected by the founder Walter Gropius. Take a break in the museum's café or in the old town. Afterwards, you can choose to visit the first Bauhaus show house, **Haus Am Horn**, the Art Nouveau places like the Haus Hohe Pappeln or the Nietzsche Archive. Or simply immerse yourself in the 20s and 30s at the exhibition or the **House of the Weimar Republic**. The choice is yours, it just depends on your taste and time budget. If you don't have the time, Weimar awaits your next visit!
